Comment	The Committee is studying how the rules-based international trading system supports open, fair and development friendly trade that is socially inclusive and environmentally sustainable. Its interim report examines mutually supportive trade and environmental measures in the public and private law spheres as well as climate and energy measures in the form of trade and the green economy, such as carbon markets and border carbon adjustment measures. The report also covers trade and natural and energy resources in the matter of fisheries subsidies and forestry management, as well as energy subsidies in international trade law, and green procurement.
